THE FACULTY AND FACULTY SENATE

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I: THE FACULTY

The Faculty shall consist of all persons identified as members of the Faculty as defined in

- 3. The officers of the Faculty Senate shall be President, President-elect, Secretary, and other officers as designated in the Bylaws of the Faculty and Faculty Senate.
- 4. The Faculty Senate shall communicate with the Faculty on an ongoing basis.

ARTICLE IV: THE FUNCTIONS OF THE FACULTY SENATE

The Faculty Senate shall

- 1. act for the Faculty;
- 2. carry out any and all mandates given it by the Faculty;
- 3. call meetings of the Faculty;
- 4. establish and facilitate the operations of such committees as it deems necessary.

ARTICLE V: CONSTITUTIONAL IMPLEMENTATION AND AMENDMENTS

- 1. The Faculty Senate shall implement the provisions of this Constitution through Bylaws.
- 2. Articles of this Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of those full-time Faculty voting in a general referendum, by secret ballot.
