

The following document summarizes the opinions of likely voters in Missouri on issues related to charter schools. These results are from SLU/YouGov Polls conducted from June 2020 to February 2024. The SLU/YouGov Poll is a biannual survey of likely Missouri voters aiming to inform policymakers, citizens, and researchers of Missourians' opinions on important issues facing the state.

52% of Missouri voters believe charter schools should be allowed to operate in their local district (<u>Aug. 2023 Poll</u>) 55% of Missouri voters believe charter schools should be allowed to operate across the state (<u>Aug. 2023 Poll</u>) Less than 40% of Missouri voters correctly identify Missouri charter schools as public schools (<u>June 2020 Poll</u>)
